'First Christian Church Parsonage'

In 1911, the First Christian Church in Noblesville purchased the residence located adjacent to the church at the southeast corner of Maple Avenue and Ninth Street. The residence was remodeled and was used as the parsonage for the church. The house is shown in the photo with the church wrapping around it on the south and east sides.

The church building was extensively remodeled in 1970 and as part of that project the house was removed. A residence in Wellington Heights was then purchased and used as the parsonage until 1979. It was then sold and the church began using a cash parsonage allowance instead of providing a residence for the pastor.
